

MESH PANEL DISPLAY WALLS FOR the E-Z UP CANOPY

(Fits all Pop-up Canopies)

Instructions for Assembly

PARTS LIST:

(3) 115" wide Mesh Panel for E-Z up

Note: Do not store or carry poles or parts in Mesh Panel carry bag.

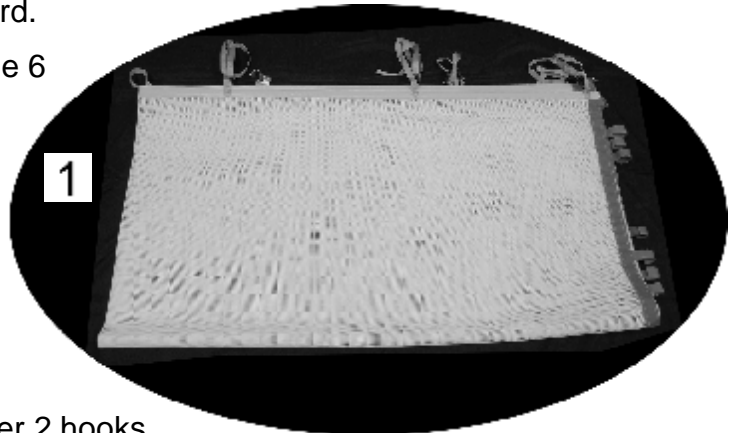
First, install the StaBar Kit stabilizing bars on your E-Z UP or other pop up canopy. Follow the StaBar setup instructions. Then, use these instructions to install your Mesh Panels:

IMPORTANT: If you are using *ProGallery* covers on your Mesh Panels, you must face the Velcro-edged side of the Mesh Panel inward. If the Mesh Panels are to be used without covers, face the Velcro-edged side outward.

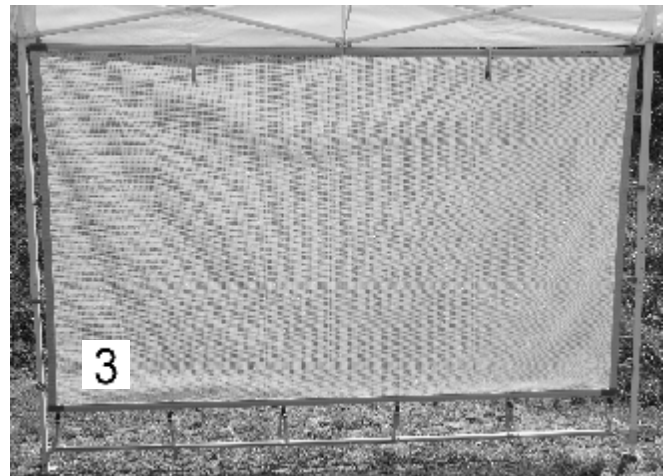
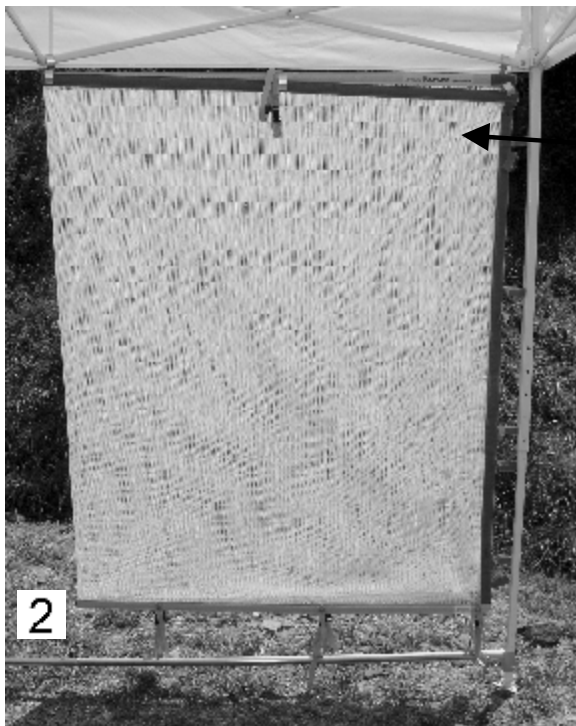
1. Unroll Mesh Panel so that you have the 6 metal hooks in your hand.

Note: If you are putting your Mesh Panels onto the EZ-UP framework you will not need two of the hooks

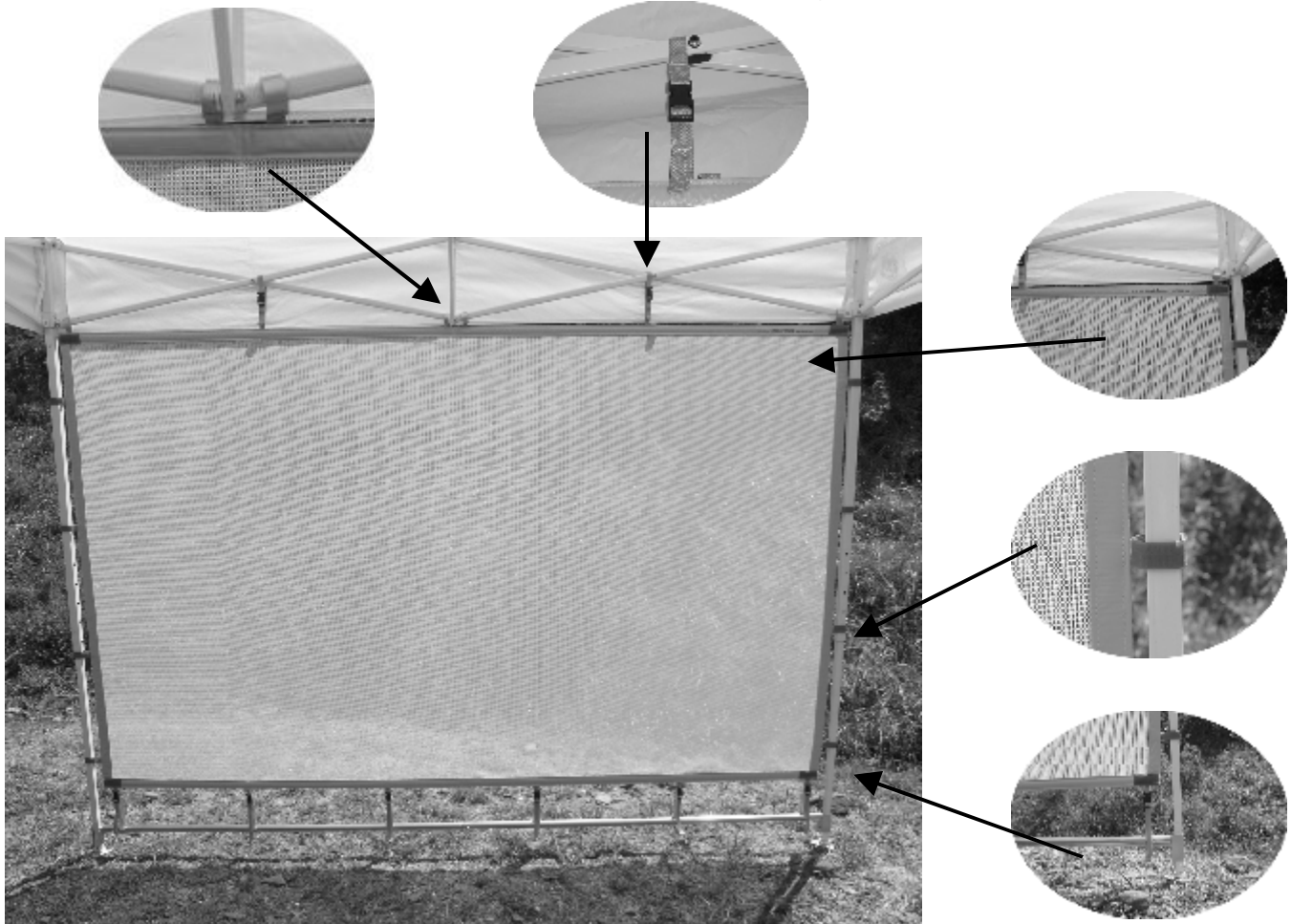
2. Attach 2 hooks from one side of the Mesh Panel to the EZ-Up frame.
3. Unfold Mesh Panel and attach the other 2 hooks.



Note: Metal hooks go to the top of the framework.



4. Wrap the buckle straps at the top of the Mesh Panel around the “X” of the frame, and click the buckle closed. **Do not cinch straps up tight as overly tight straps will tend to pull the metal hooks off of the framework.**
5. Check to see that the Mesh Panel is evenly spaced between the legs. Return to the buckle strap at the center of each half of the wall and adjust so that it is even with the metal hooks. *You will not have to adjust this setting for future set-ups.
6. Attach buckles at the bottom of the Mesh Panel to the lower StaBar pole and pull straps tight.
7. Attach the Velcro straps on the sides of the Mesh Panel to the canopy or booth frame legs beginning with the top two on one side.
8. Attach top two Velcro straps on the opposite side – while pulling panel to make it taut.
9. Attach lower two Velcro straps on each side, while pulling panel taut.



The specially woven and heat-treated mesh of your Mesh Panels will support items up to 15 pounds using a pair of S-hooks (we recommend using S-hooks in pairs for every item displayed). For heavier or bulkier items, use our Straphangers (see catalog or find them on our website – www.flourish.com.)

HELPFUL HINT: When packing up, re-attach Velcro straps while removing panel. This will make the next set-up easier. **DO NOT STORE OR CARRY POLES IN MESH PANEL BAG!!! USE BLACK BALL BUNGEEES PROVIDED TO BUNDLE, TRANSPORT, & STORE POLES.**
